

Villa Laeli is set on a panoramic position on the hills of Miata, a private compound of 12 villas not far from Porto Cervo, Costa Smeralda's main centre with an incredible 270° view on the Maddalena Islands and Corsica. The property matches the typical characteristics of the local architectural patterns and the use building materials such as marbles, white granites is well mashed to meet all standards of a high-level, elegant and sophisticated dwelling respecting nature with touch of Mediterranean modern elegance. The architectural project has made the most of all the volumes making up the 1.600 sqm living area: in particular the living area opens onto a large terrace overlooking the infinity pool, creating continuity with the interior and exterior, between the sea and the Archipelago of La Maddalena and Corsica, apparently flowing harmoniously into one another. The villa is set in a garden of 15.000 sqm of Mediterranean scrub, granite rocks, lawn and flowers enriched with marble fountains and bronze sculptures.
